

## South Downs Way/Monarch's Way (starting near Storringon)

**OFF ROAD** 

Experienced 13 miles (20.92 km) 2½ hours

Map - Explorer 121 Arundel & Pulborough

This is a varied route with some long ascents and descents on good surfaces plus shorter, steeper and more technical sections of single track. It takes advantage of the more open sections of the South Downs

Way and links in with the wooded southerly section following The Monarch's Way. Views to the south-west are spectacular taking in Littlehampton, Bognor Regis (you can see the white dome at Butlins), Arundel Castle and the Isle of Wight in the distance.



1. Start at Kithurst Hill car park (GR070125) off the B2139 Storrington to Amberley road. Go right from the car park along The South Downs Way. Leave The South Downs Way and go left at the end of a small wood on a public right of way (GR061125). Carry straight over bridleway crossroads, past the Burgh, veering right to keep on bridleway. Go left at next junction (GR045110) and left again onto a well-surfaced bridleway. Continue past Peppering High Barn

onto lane. Go left at T-junction to meet road on outskirts of Burpham. Go straight over junction. Pass Wepham Barn Farm to crossroads of roads and bridleway (GR044084).

- 2. Left along concrete-surfaced bridleway to left bend. Turn right here through gate and downhill on a steep bridleway and left at junction at bottom of hill.
- 3. Immediately turn right up short steep bridleway (GR049077) and continue for 3½ miles (5.63 km). Then go over first bridleway crossroads and left through woods on tarmac section of Monarch's Way. Continue east past cottage on right where tarmac runs out. Bear right at T-junction of bridleways (G076082), down gentle slope and left after 80 metres at junction of tracks and along broad, muddy bridleway. Left at next crossroads down steep, technical section to T-junction with road.
- 4. Left on road and right on bridleway just past Michelgrove Bungalow. Go through Myrtle Grove Farm, over drive to Long Furlong Farm and continue on Monarch's Way, avoiding Tolmare Farm, to junction with A280 just west of Findon.
- 5. Left on bridleway by metal gate and continue north to junction by barn with South Downs Way. Left along South Downs Way past Chantry Post to car park.
