This walk circles the historic Rackham Hill and affords good views of Parham House, Amberley Wild Brooks and Amberley Castle.

1. Starting from the Kithurst Hill car park go through the double gates and turn right (west) on to the South Downs Way. Follow this footpath, ignoring the first footpath on your left. Along this section you will be able to get good

views of Parham House and Amberley Wild Brooks.

2. After about a mile and a half you will come across a junction where a footpath crosses the South Downs Way (If you want to enjoy the views over towards Arundel Castle and the coast you can climb the bank on the left). At the crossroads take the footpath to the left. Follow this path along the hedgerow, keeping it on your right-hand side.



- **3**. When the footpath emerges onto a well defined track turn left up the hill.
- **4**. At the top of the hill the path the path joins the South Downs Way again. Turn right and follow the footpath back to Kithurst car park.
