

Horsham/Rusper


ON ROAD

Intermediate 13 miles (20.92 km) 1½ hours

Map - Explorer 134 Crawley & Horsham

This route uses predominately country lanes, passing through beautiful scenery and provides superb views across the Low Weald. The route includes a number of steep hills.

- 1. Start at Leechpool Woods car park (GR194314) off the Harwood Road on the eastern side of Horsham. Turn right into Harwood Road. Straight over at the traffic lights. This is a busy road at peak times.
- 2. Pass The Norfolk Arms and turn right into Old Crawley Road. After 165 metres turn left by the engineering works, down an embankment and cross the A264 Crawley road. Take care crossing this busy dual-carriageway.



- 3. Continue along Wimland Road past The Frog & Nightgown pub and up the steep hill. The view at the top is great.
- 4. You now have a choice of routes.

Either: **4a** The shorter route: Go straight on turning right at the junction with Horsham Road and continue to Rusper.

- **Or: 4b** Turn right, down Wimland Lane then left at the next junction into Faygate Lane and right at the following junction into Lambs Green. Follow the road to Rusper.
- 5. Turn left at The Star Inn, Rusper. The shorter route re-joins at the next left-hand junction.
- 6. Continue along the Horsham Road and turn right down Green Lane towards Langhurst.
- 7. At the next junction turn left into Langhurstwood Road and back over the A264 Horsham bypass.
- 8. Turn left into Pondtail Road, over the next roundabout and turn right at the next roundabout into Rusper Road (use cycle lane).
- 9. Continue over the level crossing and take 2nd exit at the next roundabout Redkiln Way.
- 10. At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit, Harwood Road, back to Leechpool Woods.
