

If my application is accepted I agree to abide by the conditions and regulations of Horsham District Council as listed below:

What you can expect from us:

- 1 All staffing ratios for children's activities meet requirements laid down by The Children's Act and National Governing Bodies for Sport. eg Kayaking 1:8 placid water, 1:4 tidal waters (minimum of 2 instructors)
- 2 All activities will be led by a qualified individual with the appropriate safety and coaching endorsements. There will be a qualified first aider on site with access to a first aid box.
- 3 Provision of properly serviced and maintained transport (where offered) with forward facing seating and seat belts.
- 4 Provision, where offered, of properly serviced and maintained and appropriate equipment (eg Trampoline, Rock Climbing Helmets, etc). **NB Where individuals choose to use their own equipment (ice skates, mountain bikes, etc.) the District Council will not be responsible.**
- 5 Any child to be met or picked up by an adult will be safely looked after and supervised for at least 30 minutes until parent/guardian arrives. Parents are asked not to exploit this commitment and should be punctual. Leaders have other responsibilities to attend to once children have departed!

Other things you should know:

- 1 Unless instructions are heeded, some Leisure Link activities can be hazardous. Horsham District Council reserve the right to ban individuals from future activities if they are considered to behave in a dangerous or unruly manner.
- 2 For certain activities, children aged 8 or under may only be accepted if accompanied by an adult.
