



## Steyning/Ashurst/Wiston

### ON ROAD

Intermediate

14 miles (22.53 km)

This route starts and finishes in the ancient and attractive village of Steyning, which is worthy of detailed exploration as indeed is Bramber. The route uses mainly country lanes but part of the route includes a short distance along the A24 dual carriageway. The route passes through farmland and provides excellent views of the South Downs.

1. Park at Steyning in the free car park by the Health Centre (GR175114). Turn left into Tanyard Lane then right into the High Street. Follow the Horsham Road westwards past the Steyning Leisure Centre on your right. At the A283 turn left and immediately right continuing on Horsham Road towards Ashurst.

2. Once you have reached Ashurst, turn left into School Lane. Follow the road round past the primary school. Just around the corner take a left turn down Peppers Lane. This road takes a sharp right turn and becomes Honeybridge Lane.

3. Follow Honeybridge Lane for some time until you reach a caravan site on your left where you turn left. This lane brings you out onto the A24 which is a very busy dual carriageway. You need to head south (left) for about 500 metres, until you reach the next left turn, which takes you back onto a bridleway.

4. Pass Woodmans Farm on your left and follow the bridleway southwards towards Wiston.

5. At the end of this route take a left turn into Hole Street. Further on, just before the Wiston Tea Rooms, turn left into Spithandle Lane heading back towards Ashurst.

6. Follow Spithandle Lane to the end and take a right turn towards Steyning.

This is the road which you travelled up at the start of the ride and is the point where you have completed the circular part of the route. Follow the road back to Steyning and the car park.
