

Assessment  The site is currently an operational sand quarry in the countryside unrelated to any built-up area boundary (BUAB) and is therefore not in accordance with the HDPF settlement strategy. The site is also adjacent to an archaeological site and the Rock Mill grade II listed building. There are also continual dewatering taking place for the purpose of the sand extraction and continued waste management operations being undertaken place at the site, north of the highway (The Hollow). Plans for a suitable long term restoration of this area are being prepared. Given the isolated location and current status of this site, it is assessed as Not Currently Developable.

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

Proposed Land Use: Economic & Tourism Assessment						
The site is currently an operational sand quarry in the countryside unrelated to any built-up area boundary (BUAB) and is therefore not in accordance with the HDPF settlement strategy. There are significant landform challenges with the site to the south of the highway (The Hollow), where the topography ranges from 75 metres AOD to 10 metres AOD (at the base of the quarry). There is continual dewatering taking place for the purpose of the sand extraction and continued waste management operations taking place at the site. Plans for a suitable long term restoration of this area are being prepared. Given the isolated location and current status of the site it is assessed as Not Currently Developable.
