

**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990
SECTION 257 and PARAGRAPH 1 of SCHEDULE 14**

**HORSHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL
PUBLIC FOOTPATH no. 2360 (PART)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020**

The Council made the above Order on 17 December 2020. The effect of the Order will be to divert an existing section of Footpath No. 2360, which is shown by a continuous black line between Points A-C on the Order Map, on land on the south west side of Hooklands Lane, Coolham, West Sussex.

The new route of the path, having a minimum width of 2 metres throughout commences at Point A on the Order Map (Grid Ref: N120098 E512473) and drops down in a Southerly direction for approximately 300 metres to Point B (Grid Ref: N119828 E512375), turning westwards for approximately 300 metres to Point C (Grid Ref: 119845 E512206) as shown by a broken black line on the Order Map.

A copy of the Order and the Order Map may be inspected free of charge at the Horsham District Council Offices at Parkside, Chart way, Horsham, West Sussex RH12 1RL between the hours of 9AM AND 5PM Monday to Fridays (excluding bank holidays and public holidays) from 14 January 2021 to 11th February 2021. A copy may also be viewed on the Council's website www.horsham.gov.uk.

Any representations about, or objections to, the Order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to the Head of Legal and Democratic Services, Horsham District Council, at Parkside, Chart way, Horsham, West Sussex RH12 1RL no later than 11TH February 2021 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are made, or if made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
