I am very disappointed and strongly oppose the recent proposal for planning development in Southwater, namely Site 4F and 4m.

We haven't received any formal notification about this development, and only found out through contact with neighbours. This is unacceptable in our opinion. We had also very recently enquired about any such plans, literally in the last month, but were assured there was nothing being proposed at this stage.

This site 4F is located directly behind our house, so will obviously have a huge impact on our home/life.

The development itself will cause noise, air pollution and be a general disturbance to our daily life, and as a young family are very concerned about how this might affect our children's health and wellbeing.

It will also affect the level of privacy and natural light that we have in our home, which was a big reason in choosing our home originally. The proposed site is directly behind, so any new homes will be able to see directly in, it will also block natural light into the home. This will almost certainly reduce the value in our property. will we be compensated for this?

We were originally attracted to Southwater for its peacefulness, beautiful countryside views, local nature and close village community, This is something we cherish and enjoy on a daily basis, so this kind of disruption will spoil the life we have and village we call home.

The village has already suffered from large developments such as Broadacres, which have taken away some of the natural beauty of this area. Any further development will impact this more, and change what was a small village into more of a busy town. There will also have an impact on local farming and agriculture.

Local services have not kept up with the recent housing developments, as we have found already that schools, dentists and doctors are all over subscribed.

Please do not continue with this proposal.
