STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT ADOPTION STATEMENT

NOTICE is hereby given that Horsham District Council has formally adopted the Statement of Community Involvement on 25 January 2017, in accordance with the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012.

The Statement of Community Involvement sets out how the Council will work with the community as well as partners and stakeholders in the production of Local Development Framework documents and the determination of Development Management Applications; it outlines the consultation and involvement processes and monitoring arrangements. This document is a review of the Statement of Community Involvement Adopted in 2013.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Statement of Community Involvement may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision to adopt the document. Any challenge must be made on the grounds that either the document has not been prepared within the powers conferred by the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, or alternatively that a requirement of the Act or associated regulations has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 15 March 2017.
