

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER
Highways Act 1980

Horsham District Council (Billingshurst)
Public Path (No 780_1) Diversion Order 2020

The above Order was made on [*date order signed and sealed*] under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order will be to extinguish the route of Public footpath No 780_1 from Point A (OS grid reference TQ 504585, 123699) to Point B (OS grid reference TQ 504682 123610) which runs through two barns on the site and is approximately 128 meters in length as indicated on the Plan and to substitute this with a new Public footpath which runs from Point B (OS grid reference TQ 504682 123610) to Point A (OS grid reference TQ 504585, 123699) which is a route running between a hedge and a barn and then across an open field with a length of approximately 137 meters and having a width of 2 meters as shown on the Plan.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, then Horsham District Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
