NOTES

When a lottery has been held, the promoter must send a return to the Council during the period of three months beginning with the day on which the draw (or the last draw) in the lottery took place. The return must be certified by two members of the society (other than the promoter) being persons of full age appointed in writing by the governing body of the society. Failure to send a return in accordance with the statutory provisions constitutes an offence.

Note 1 At least 20% of the lottery proceeds must be applied to the purposes of the society (schedule 11, paragraph 33)

Note 2 No single prize may be worth more than £25,000 (schedule 11, paragraph 34)

Note 3 Every ticket in the lottery must cost the same and the ticket fee must be paid to the society (ie the society must take payment) before entry into the draw is allowed. (schedule 11, paragraph 37)
