What improvements or modifications would you suggest?						

1. The golf course acts as a buffer between Horsham + Southwater + should remain as such.
2. The building of 500 houses and potentially 1750 people with only 1 road (+ potentially 2) with no amenities other than a farm shop is very restrictive + will require almost 1000 vehicles.
3. The offer of a bridge + an infants school is not suited to an aging population + would be ill placed.
4. To allow housing when an 18 hole golf course that is only 5 years old is very poor long term planning for the local population.
5. To change the Council owned "Rookwood Golf from 18 to 9 would be better for the tax payers of the Area.
