This route uses mainly country lanes, the Downs Link and a bridleway, but there are two short parts along the main A281 road which can be busy at peak times. The route passes through farmland and gives good views of the South Downs and the Adur Valley.



1. Start at the library car park, High Street, Henfield (GR215162). Turn left onto the High Street and left again into Church Street. Go past the police station and Old Railway Tavern.

2. Turn right onto the Downs Link towards Partridge Green just past the Old Railway Tavern and follow the Downs Link until it reaches the B2135.

3. Turn right. Go over the bridge at Partridge Green. Turn right onto the High Street (The Partridge pub is on your left). Continue along this road until you reach the A281, Cowfold/Henfield Road.

4. Turn right towards Henfield for about 1 mile (1.60 km). This is a busy road with fast traffic.

5. Turn left, through iron gates, onto bridleway marked as a private road to Shermanbury parish church and continue until you reach Frylands Lane leading to Wineham. Turn right at Wineham, past a telephone box on your right and continue down Wineham Lane to road junction.

6. Take the right turn, Wheatsheaf Road, to Henfield past the Wheatsheaf Pub.

7. Rejoin the A281 to Henfield (this is a busy road at peak times) and return to the car park.
