

My Voting Passport Information



This passport may be used by anyone who requires additional assistance at the polling station.

Before polling day:

- Complete your voting passport details on the next page.
- Check what assistance is available by visiting our website [here](#).
- Make a plan for voting, think about:
 - Who might help you vote (if you need it) at the election.
 - What support you might need to vote.
 - Find out who the candidates are and what they stand for.
 - Make sure you have valid photo ID or a Voter Authority Certificate.

On polling day:

- Bring your photo ID (e.g. passport, photo driving license, disabled or older person's bus pass, PASS card or blue badge), or a Voter Authority Certificate.
- Show your voting passport to polling station staff and let them know you need support.

If you cannot access the polling station, tell the Presiding Officer. They will bring the ballot paper to you.

You may bring your own pen or pencil.

You may also:

- Take someone to assist you with voting (they must be aged 18 or over).
- Ask the Presiding Officer for help, including reading candidates or marking your ballot paper.

What other people can't do:

- Decide for you.
- Mark the ballot paper against your wishes.
- Stop you from voting because you have a disability.
