Thank you for consulting Historic England on the submission version of the Henfield Neighbourhood Plan. As the Government's advisor on planning for the historic environment, our remit is limited to those areas where the plan could have effects for heritage assets or it might be desirable to promote better design in historic places. Silence on other areas of plan making should not be treated as consent.

I am pleased to say that, without prejudice to comments we may wish to make on individual applications in the plan area, we do not wish to raise any areas of concern and are pleased to see that the Neighbourhood Plan steering group have sought to accommodate our comments and suggestions made at the Regulation 14 consultation stage.
